CATEGORY A

AV brief not required

GENERAL

- The airfield lies 6NM to the W of the centre of the city on a coastal plain

Threats

Runway Excursion

- RWY05 and RW11 both have steep final approach paths (3.4°) and RNAV approach VPA will exceed 3.5° when the temperature is greater than 22°C
- Runway 23 will be used as a preferential runway with up to 5kts tailwind

Runway Incursion

- Hotspot exists at intersection of P and S taxiways, refer to aerodrome chart in Navigraph/LIDO

Special Considerations

- Use of RWY 11/29 prohibited for A350, B747, B777 and B787 aircraft due to wingspan restrictions
- Initial level on SIDs is a FL

Approach

- Circling prohibited SE of 05/23 and N of 11/29

GROUND

- Restrictions are in place for cross-bleed starts, in the event of the APU being u/s coordination with the station staff will be necessary and inform ATC prior to requesting start-up

DEPARTURE

- SIDs will not be cancelled below 5000' and tracks must be followed exactly to avoid noise violations. NADP 1 procedures are mandatory for all departures

WEATHER

- The airfield weather is influenced by Atlantic depressions year round and occasionally by the Azores high
- Winter is generally quite mild with prevailing westerly winds, Atlantic lows will bring rain and windy conditions. When the Azores high dominates the weather is generally good but fog may form at night with occasional frosts. The Siberian high can bring freezing temperatures and snow
- Summer is generally warm with an average July daytime temperature of 27°C although cool rainy periods can occur with the passage of Atlantic lows. There is a marked sea-breeze effect during the summer months.
