Elevation 496ft

AV brief – not required

GENERAL

- Budapest Ferenc Liszt (formerly Ferihegy) is to the E of the city.
- It is 30nm SE of the border with Slovakia.

Threats**CFIT**

- Terrain 25nm NW giving an SSA of 3600ft.
- It is shown well on the IACs for Rwy 13L and 13R.

ARRIVAL

- Approach Noise Abatement at “Nighttime” (after 2200L): Expect long-final routing to join Final Approach via Intermediate Fix:
 - 13R: Expect restriction to establish via BP010, with track shortening prior e.g. route direct VEBOS, BP419, BP010.
 - 31R: Expect restriction to establish via BP030, with track shortening prior e.g. route direct VEBOS, BP 061, BP030.

BAV Crew Reports

- *Rwy 31R – Short cut after RUTOL and before BP523.*

GROUND

- Requirement for certain aircraft types to shut down the port engine once established on centreline of some stands.
 - Shut down left ENG just after turning onto CL of stands 31, 42-45 (A319)
- Exercise caution with stand guidance to ensure the correct stopping position is achieved, particularly on stands 31, 32 and 37.
- Minimum fuel uplift is 1000 L.
