

SAINT JOHNS (YYT/CYYT)

Elevation 461ft

CATEGORY A

AV brief – not required

GENERAL

- Newfoundland, Canada, St Johns airport is 3 nm NW of the city. It was formerly known as Torbay – as the VOR is still named.
- Local time is z-2:30 and they do apply daylight savings change.

Threats

Runway Excursion

- Rwy 16 threshold turning pan – consider using 11/29 and 16/34 intersection for backtracking the Rwy. Turning pan at threshold is a smaller area but still ok for 180° turn with caution.

Loss of Control

CAUTION: *Moderate to severe turbulence may be anticipated.*

ARRIVAL

Approach

- Rwy 29 rad Alt: terrain on final approach will cause the Rad Alt to ramp up by approx. 65ft after the Cat2 DH.

WEATHER

- Rwy 29 rad Alt: terrain on final approach will cause the Rad Alt to ramp up by approx. 65ft after the Cat2 DH.
- Temperatures vary from approx -9°C in winter to 21°C in summer, and rarely go below -15°C or above 25°C.
- Snow fall occurs generally from November to April.
