

ARUBA (AUA/TNCA)

Elevation 62ft

CATEGORY B

AV brief – not required

GENERAL

- Aruba is a generally flat, riverless island in the Leeward Antilles island arc of the Lesser Antilles in the southern part of the Caribbean. It lies 42 nm west of Curaçao and 15 nm north of Venezuela's Paraguaná Peninsula.
- Airport is located on the south-west coast of the island.
- No significant terrain in the vicinity.

Threats

- Circling height is above 1000ft Ha.
- Tall marine vessels up to 300ft AMSL may be in the departure area of Rwy 11. Should this occur IFR departures will be prohibited. "EXTRA RWY DATA" accounting for these vessels will be available from Perf should a VFR departure be required.

GROUND

Taxiing

- Use of Twy C between runway and apron prohibited due wingspan.
- Rwy 29 requires a backtrack for departure.

Parking

- BAV aircraft will use stands 1, 2 and 3.

Pushback

- Flight crew request pushback from the tower.
- Once pushback clearance has been received the pushback team **must** also contact the tower to request push.
- Pushback team then confirm "clear to push" with the flight crew.

DEPARTURE

- Rwy 11 TORA is measured from the extreme western end of the runway. Follow the right-hand taxiway to join the runway.
